



Friends of the Solana Beach Library 2019 Educational Scholarships

Deadline: April 30, 2019

Award Amount: \$2,000 each

Purpose of the Scholarships:

To provide financial assistance in the form of **three \$2,000 educational scholarships** to graduating high-school seniors or continuing or returning students who live within the city limits of Solana Beach, for continuing education at a community college, a four-year college or university, a graduate/professional school, or a technical/vocational/career school, in the United States. Scholarships will be given to three students. Each scholarship is a one-time award.

Scholarship Committee:

The Board of Directors of the Friends of the Solana Beach Library has assembled a Scholarship Committee to review written applications and references and select the three scholarship recipients for approval by the Board.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible, an applicant must live within the boundaries of the city of Solana Beach, have a San Diego County library card (available at the Solana Beach Library), have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 (verified by the school) for the most recent three years for which a GPA is available, and demonstrate financial need. The applicant cannot be a family member or a member of the household of a Director of the Friends of the Solana Beach library, and cannot be a recipient of a 2018 scholarship from the Friends.

Application Process:

The application for the 2019 Friends of the Solana Beach Library Scholarship can be downloaded as a PDF from the Friends website www.friendsofsolanabeachlibrary.org/scholarship and printed by the applicant. Alternatively, printed applications are available at the Solana Beach Library — if you don't see the display, ask a librarian.

As described on the application, the student must complete and submit the **application form** by **April 30, 2019**, along with an **essay**, a completed **permission form**, and **two letters of recommendation** (at least one letter should be from a teacher and the other from an adult who is not related to the student and who can provide information about the student to the Scholarship Committee).

For each application received, the Scholarship Committee will email a **notification of receipt** to the applicant. Applicants should receive notification within a week of submission. If not, they should first check their Spam folder, and if they don't find it there, **contact the Scholarship Committee: FOSBL2019A@aol.com**

Selection Criteria:

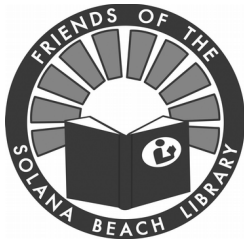
The Scholarship Committee will consider financial need, GPA, community activities, extracurricular activities, awards and recognition, and the two letters of recommendation.

Award Notification:

A member of the Scholarship Committee will contact each scholarship recipient via a letter from the Friends of the Solana Beach Library in May, 2019.

Procedures for Receiving the Award:

Each scholarship recipient must verify acceptance in a community college, college or university, graduate/professional school, or vocational/technical/career school before the scholarship check will be released.
